My advice to other families experiencing homeless is not to lose hope, not all is lost. There are still people like those at PVSS who can help you. Also, if you want to, you can do anything." Obdulia has moved out of homelessness and lives with her husband Adrian (pictured) and their children in a 3 bedroom home.

When Lucia lost her job and housing, she was expecting her first child. Not having family to assist her, she came to PVSS and found a safe haven for herself and
